

Public transport to and from Newcastle Waldorf School

There are a number of public buses that provide transport options to and from Newcastle Waldorf School. To find the most convenient for you, visit the Transport for NSW Trip Planner <https://transportnsw.info/trip#/> and follow these tips:

- Firstly, click the **'Refine'** option, and select **'School bus'** under **'Public Transport Options'**. Click **'Apply'**
- Type your **'From'** location
- In the **'To'** location, you will need to type **"Newcastle Rudolf Steiner School"**
- Try filtering on an arrival time and
- Select a suitable service.

The application must be completed by:

- A parent or guardian if the student is under 16 years of age, or
- The student if they are 16 years and over.

We do, however, have teachers on duty at the end of the day to assist students onto the correct buses if required.
